2025 Student Scholarship Program

In 2007, NW Priority Credit Union established the NW Priority Credit Union Student Scholarship. It is awarded annually to graduating high school seniors or college students. This year we will award four (4) \$1,000.00 scholarships to members who demonstrate academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, financial need, and community service.

Eligibility

- Must be a **primary member** in good standing* of NW Priority Credit Union for at **least 1 year**.
- Be a graduating senior or current college student with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale who will enroll in an undergraduate course of study during the 2025/2026 school year, at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school in the U.S.
- Official family and employees of NWPCU and their families (parents, children, siblings, and spouses) are not eligible to receive a scholarship.

Requirements

Completed NW Priority Credit Union Student Scholarship application.

Original Written Essay of AT LEAST 500 WORDS or more, TYPED and DOUBLE-SPACED on ONE of the following topics:

- A) Credit Unions are not-for-profit financial institutions whose purpose is to serve their members. How can NWPCU better appeal to and serve its GenZ members?
- B) Describe your most meaningful (or significant) achievement(s) and how they relate to your field of study or future goals?

Two Letters of Recommendations from your teacher, professor, volunteer instructor, employer and/or coach.

Official Sealed Transcripts:

- High School Seniors Enclose your most recent high school transcript showing Grade Point Average.
- · College freshmen Enclose high school and college transcripts.
- Other Students Enclose transcripts of college work
- Other Applicants Enclose a typewritten letter of qualification and three references.

Notice of acceptance to chosen post-secondary school – if you have received it.

Deadline

Entries must be postmarked and submitted to NW Priority Credit Union by **March 27, 2025**Entries may be delivered to any of our five branch locations or mailed to:
